Formal photographs

In order to make this process less time consuming and confusing for all parties involved, your help in the selection of your formal groupings is essential. Our standard formal groupings are listed below. We're flexible and realize that you may not be able to forecast every-thing as you're sitting down filling this out. This is a starter guide for us, as we know each minute counts to keep up with your agenda for the day.

For your information, the following list will generally take 15 minutes with the cooperation of all involved

- * Bride and Groom with Bride's parents
- * Bride and Groom with Bride's immediate family
- * Bride and Groom with Groom's parents
- * Bride and Groom with Groom's immediate family
- * Bride and Groom with all bridal party
- * Bride and Groom with each respective party

If you wish to add extended family into the formals, I recommend taking one large Bride side / Groom side shot as opposed to large numbers of smaller groupings.

Please note, it is very important that you consider time restraints when adding to this list of formal photographs. you can estimate an average of 3-4 minutes per grouping. It is absolutely vital that everyone who is in the formal groupings be ready to begin the session at the stated time. in order to not waste time searching for missing individuals, please be sure to communicate this to all those you would like to participate.

The Timeline - Ceremony and Reception Details

Estimated number of Wedding guests attending:

At minimum (depending on the chosen package) we will arrive from 30 minutes to 2 hours prior to the ceremony This allows us time to shoot the preparations of both the Bride and Groom. This will also allow for time for candid, or less formal, shots of the respective wedding parties.
